Questions and Answers for Request for Proposals (RFP) 2009-07 Public Housing Mitigation Initiative

Question 1:

Bradenton Housing Authority is not listed as an eligible applicant under the Attachment A. We are a small Housing Authority by definition since we only have 245 units. We would like to apply for these funds. We received \$631,982 in ARRA funds and would need to know how much we will be able to apply for under your program.

Answer:

The list of Small PHAs appearing on Attachment A was prepared based on the sources noted and input provided to Florida Housing by the stakeholders during the development of the RFP, which included public workshops. However, the fact that an otherwise eligible PHA does not appear on Attachment A in no way precludes it from submitting a response to the RFP. Based on ARRA funding in the amount of \$631,982, Bradenton Housing Authority would be eligible to apply for up to \$75,000 in funds under the terms of the RFP. It should be noted that the maximum funding amounts (the prorata share) listed for each PHA on Attachment A were developed as estimates based on the assumption that the list included all eligible PHAs. The actual amount of funds awarded to any successful applicant will be determined by Florida Housing following its review and evaluation of all responses.
