PETITIONER APC FOUR FORTY FOUR, LTD'S FIRST SET OF INTERROGATORIES TO RESPONDENT FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION

Pursuant to Florida Rule of Civil Procedure 1.340 and the Order of Pre-Hearing Instructions, Petitioner APC Four Forty Four, Ltd., ("APC") requests that Respondent Florida Housing Finance Corporation ("FHFC") answer the following interrogatories separately and fully in writing, under oath.

#### INSTRUCTIONS AND DEFINITIONS

- 1. Please answer each interrogatory in the space provided, using additional sheets where your answers exceed that space.
- 2. In answering these interrogatories, you must furnish all information, unless privileged, that is known or available to you irrespective of whether this information is possessed directly by you or by agents, members, employees, representatives or investigators and all others from whom they may freely obtain information as well as your attorneys and their investigators.

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You must list by general description any and all information that is not furnished on grounds of privilege or other grounds and must state the objection and basis on which that privilege or other ground is asserted.

- 3. If any of these interrogatories cannot be answered in full, answer the interrogatory to the fullest extent possible and specify the reasons for the inability to answer the remainder and state whatever information, knowledge, or belief you have concerning the unanswered portion. Give any information in your possession that may partially answer the interrogatory or subpart that you cannot answer in full or that may lead to APC discovering the answer thereto.
- 4. These interrogatories are continuing in nature and you are required to supplement your responses with any additional responsive information that is subsequently obtained by you or any person on your behalf.
- 5. As used in this document, unless the context indicates otherwise, the following words and phrases are defined as follows:
  - a. "Person" means any natural person, firm, partnership, association, proprietorship, joint venture, corporation, governmental agency, or other organization or legal or business entity.
  - b. "Identify" when used in reference to an individual person, means to state the person's full name, home address, job title, business or employment address, and telephone number. When used in reference to a person other than an individual person, "identify" means to state whether that person is a corporation, partnership, governmental unit, or other organization, and the name, present address, and phone number of the person. When used in any other context, "identify" means to name, list, state, or describe the information requested.

- c. "Florida Housing" or "FHFC" means Florida Housing Finance Corporation.
- d. The term "document" includes those items listed in Florida Rule of Civil Procedure 1.350(a) and also includes, without limitation, the originals of all writings of every kind. The term "document" also includes copies of all documents that are not identical duplicates of the originals, and copies of documents if the originals of documents are not in the possession, custody or control of Florida Housing's employees, attorneys or other agents.
- e. To "state the basis for" or equivalent language of a particular claim, assertion, allegation or contention, means to:
  - 1. Identify by date, title and description each and every document (and, where pertinent, the section, article and/or subparagraph thereof), which forms any part of the source of your information;
  - 2. Identify by date, time, parties and subject matter each and every communication which forms any part of the source of your information;
  - 3. State separately any other fact that forms the basis for your information; and
  - 4. Identify each person with personal knowledge of the basis for or facts supporting the claim, assertion, allegation or contention.
- f. "Petition" means APC's Amended Formal Written Protest and Petition for Formal Administrative Proceeding filed with FHFC on March 3, 2014.

- g. "RFA" means the Request for Applications 2013-003 for Affordable Housing Developments Located in Broward, Miami-Dade and Palm Beach Counties and all addenda.
- h. "Procurement associated with the RFA" means all aspects of the FHFC's actions in connection with RFA 2013-003, including but not limited to review and scoring of Applications at any point up to and including the time when the Florida Housing Board of Directors approved the recommendation of the Review Committee.
  - i. "You" and "your" refer to FHFC and its agents and attorneys.
  - j. "All" means "any" and "any" means "all.
- k. **"Application"** means an application for an allocation of Housing Credits pursuant to RFA 2013-003.
- 1. All other terms in these Interrogatories subject to more than one interpretation shall be given their broadest possible meaning.
