Subject: ALF Unit Requirements

Ken, this email is request the removal of the requirement to have a range in every unit for ALFs. Practically, an ALF constructs a commercial kitchen and dining area to feed residents 3 meals and 2 snack per day. If assisted living residents are cooking on a stove / range in their apartments, it becomes a safety issue for them and other residents. As required by Section 42, an ALF must also supply them with a microwave so that they do have something in their apartment to warm / cook with. If a range is not required, then an ALF should be required to have a space in the cabinetry that allows for the installation of a range and is wired for a range, should a resident decides they desire one.
