

Notice of Public Hearing

Concerning Issuance of Bonds to Finance Multifamily Residential Rental Developments

Notice is hereby given that the Florida Housing Finance Corporation (“Florida Housing”) will conduct a public hearing in accordance with the Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982 (“TEFRA”) to which all interested persons are invited.

Date and Time: August 28, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. (Tallahassee local time)

Place: The offices of Florida Housing Finance Corporation, 227 North Bronough Street, Suite 5000, Tallahassee, Florida 32301

Purpose: To conduct a TEFRA hearing concerning the potential future issuance of tax-exempt bonds by Florida Housing to provide additional financing for the acquisition, construction, or rehabilitation of the following multifamily residential rental development in the aggregate face amount, not to exceed the amount listed below:

The proposed Development is Brownsville Transit Village V, a 120-unit multifamily residential rental development located at NW 29th Ave, East of the Intersection of NW 29th Ave and NW 51st Terrace, Miami, Miami-Dade County, FL 33142. The owner and operator of the development is Brownsville Village V, Ltd., located at 161 NW 6th Street, Suite 1020, Miami, FL 33136, or such successor in interest in which Brownsville Village V, Ltd., or an affiliate thereof, is a managing member, general partner and/or controlling stockholder. The prospective manager of the proposed development is Atlantic Pacific Community Management, LLC, located at 301 South College Street, 17th Floor, Charlotte, NC, 28288. The tax-exempt bond amount is not to exceed \$18,850,000.

All interested parties may present oral comments at the public TEFRA hearing or submit written comments regarding the potential bond issuance for the development being financed. Written comments should be received by Florida Housing by 5:00 PM (Tallahassee local time), August 24, 2023, and should be addressed to the attention of Tim Kennedy, Multifamily Loans and Bonds Director. Any persons desiring to present oral comments should appear at the hearing.

If requested in writing, a fact-finding hearing will be held in the county where the property is located. When possible, the local hearing will be held before the formal TEFRA hearing and comments received at the local hearing will be placed on record at the TEFRA hearing.
