Good afternoon Marisa,

We propose adding Community Resource Centers as an alternative community service to public libraries in the Miami-Dade County GEO RFA. For many years, and even more so with recent events related to COVID, the focus and most valuable contributions to low-income communities are shifting more toward provision of community resources such as emergency assistance programs for rent, utility and medical bills; assistance with unemployment and food stamp applications; programs that offer grants, education/job training, access to internet, special events, etc. Accordingly, we recommend that the Corporation add, as an alternative option to libraries, local government sponsored Community Resource Centers which offer a wide variety of social services to economically-disadvantaged individuals and families interested in achieving self-sufficiency.
