Dear Ms. Button:

We support FHFC's thinking that eligible Local Government Area of Opportunity applicants be selected from New Jurisdictions. This provision ensures a fair allocation of housing credits across "unfunded" jurisdictions and avoids disproportionate funds flowing into any one community. That being said, there is a loophole where prior-funded jurisdictions could be awarded credits in two consecutive years. For example, in the RFA 2018-110 round, if an applicant, qualifying with Local Government Area of Opportunity funding, applied as a non-profit or targeted ASL (both of which were selected before Local Government Area of Opportunity awardees), that jurisdiction could be considered a New Jurisdiction in the subsequent cycle. We would encourage you to close this loophole so that credits flow fairly across all jurisdictions.
