## EXAMPLE - Rental Assistance Supportive Housing Program

The Georgia Housing Voucher and Bridge Program is a comprehensive Permanent Supportive Housing program in operation since 2010.

#### **Target Population**

Individuals with a Serious and Persistent Mental Illness and are in a state hospital, are chronically homeless, are frequently admitted to crisis units or emergency rooms or are incarcerated.

### Program Components

- Tenant-based rental assistance and utilities paid directly to the provider; tenant pays 30% of income for rent
  - utilize HUD Fair Market Rets and Housing Quality Standards
  - Master leasing is permitted
- Bridge funding covers start-up costs: security deposits, furniture, groceries/household needs
- Housing Support Program: housing search, temporary accommodations while securing housing, landlord incentives, unit repairs to prevent evictions, up to 6 months of utility assistance while accessing benefits
  - Service provider bills Medicaid under existing unbundled services; program pays the balance
- Fidelity monitoring
- Outplacement to other programs State Housing Authority provides preference for vouchers

### Budget

\$26,000,000 in 2023

#### Households Served

2,060 currently enrolled; 5,500 have been served since inception. There is no waitlist although some vouchers are returned due to inability to secure housing
