My question is based on the apparent contradiction that exists between the two portions of Section Four. Please advise.

Section Four A.4.d. has a “note” that states, “Applications requesting SAIL must be for a proposed Development consisting of 5 or more dwelling units in each residential building.” (page 7)

Section Four A.4.f has a list of Development Types. The list includes “duplexes” and “quadraplexes”. (page 9) By definition, duplex buildings and quadraplex buildings will not have 5 units in them.
