3. d. (1) – page 11 of 106:

Public Housing Authorities are exempt from the requirements of Chapter 475, Florida Statutes – please see 475.011 Exemptions –

Any establishment operated by a Public Housing Authority regulated under Chapter 421, F.S. is also exempt from DBPR license requirements – please see http://www.myfloridalicense.com/DBPR/services-requiring-a-dbpr-license/

Please confirm that a Public Housing Authority with the relevant management experience is eligible to serve as the General Management Company.

4. c. – page 13 of 106:

Please note that Mid-Rise (4, 5 or 6 stories) is not included as an allowable development type. Please confirm that Mid-Rise developments are eligible.

Exhibit F − 5. e. − page 90 of 106:

Public Housing Authorities are unable to meet the 151 calendar day requirement for submission of audited financial statements. Audited financial statements for PHAs are due 9 months after the PHA's fiscal year end – please see § 902.33 Financial reporting requirements -

https://www.law.cornell.edu/cfr/text/24/902.33 Please consider revising the deadline for PHA applicants.

Exhibit F - 8. b. - page 98 of 106:

It appears that this section regarding rents applies to HOME funded projects. Please confirm that this section is not applicable to CDBG-DR funded projects.
