The draft RFA 2019-115 requires that the applicant select a Green Certification and fulfill the requirements needed to get that certification. Florida Housing also requires that the applicant comply with the CNA process as outlined in the RFA. However, there may be instances where the renovations needed to receive the green certification are in conflict with what is allowed by the CNA. Examples include HVAC systems or windows that have been upgraded recently as part of a capital maintenance plan. They may not meet the green cert standards but are relatively new and do not need to be replaced. How will these conflicts resolved?
