Hi Jean:

The LGAO goal in RFA 2022-201 that gives a preference for two developments that demonstrate multiple years (i.e. RFA 2021-201 & RFA 2022-201) of continuous Local Government Area of Opportunity support should be revised to give higher preference or priority to developments that have submitted for three continuous years (i.e. RFA 2020-201, RFA 2021-201, & RFA 2022-201) without being awarded as these are developments that have been prioritized as the most important by local governments.

We recommend and urge you to consider giving a preference/priority to developments which have submitted as Priority I, were eligible and qualified as LGAO in RFA years 2020, 2021, <u>and</u> 2022. There will be multiple developments that, if submitted in RFA 2022-201, would qualify and benefit from this three-year continuous and relentless support from the local municipalities.

In RFA 2021-201, a goal existed to fund *"Two Applications that qualify for the Developments that were Previously Submitted in RFA 2019-113 and RFA 2020-201 but not Awarded Preference described in Section Four, A.11.b.(1) of the RFA"*. We see no reason why that policy should be changed this year.
